The Office of Inspector General (OIG) has reviewed the recertification package submitted by the Mississippi Medicaid Fraud Control Unit (MFCU), including the MFCU's performance narrative and the responses to the director's recertification questionnaire. We have also reviewed the MFCU's annual statistical report data as well as responses to questionnaires that we shared with the OIG, Office of Investigations, Atlanta Regional Office, and to the Mississippi Division of Medicaid, Office of Program Integrity.

We have concluded that the Mississippi MFCU meets the Federal requirements for operation of a Medicaid Fraud Control Unit and recertify the MFCU for the one-year period of April 1, 2026, and ending March 31, 2027.
