As part of the recertification process, we have reviewed the following documentation submitted by the New Jersey Medicaid Fraud Control Unit (MFCU): the MFCU's recertification package, including the MFCU's narrative and responses to the director's recertification questionnaire. We have also reviewed the MFCU's annual statistical report. Additionally, we reviewed the responses to the questionnaires that were submitted to the Office of Inspector General (OIG), Office of Investigations, New York Regional Office and the New Jersey Medicaid Fraud Division.

We have concluded that the New Jersey MFCU meets the Federal requirements for operation of a Medicaid Fraud Control Unit and recertify the MFCU for a one-year period beginning March 1, 2026, and ending February 28, 2027. A reapplication for recertification should be submitted to OIG no later than January 1, 2027.
