OIG has reviewed the following documentation submitted by the Georgia Medicaid Fraud Control Unit (MFCU): the MFCU's recertification package, including the MFCU's annual report and the responses to the director's recertification questionnaire. We have also reviewed the MFCU's Annual Statistical Report. Additionally, we reviewed the responses to the questionnaire received from the Office of Inspector General Office of Investigations, Atlanta Regional Office.

We have concluded that the Georgia MFCU meets the Federal requirements for operation of a Medicaid Fraud Control Unit and recertify the MFCU for a one-year period beginning January 1, 2026, and ending December 31, 2026. A reapplication for recertification should be submitted to OIG no later than November 1, 2026.
