The Office of Inspector General (OIG) has reviewed the recertification package submitted by the District of Columbia Medicaid Fraud Control Unit (MFCU), including the MFCU's performance narrative and the responses to the director's recertification questionnaire. We have also reviewed the MFCU's annual statistical report data as well as responses to questionnaires that we shared with the OIG, Office of Investigations, Philadelphia Regional Office, and to the District of Columbia Department of Health Care Finance.
