The Office of Inspector General (OIG) has reviewed the recertification package submitted by the Utah Medicaid Fraud Control Unit (MFCU), including the MFCU's performance narrative and the responses to the director's recertification questionnaire. We have also reviewed the MFCU's Annual Statistical Report data as well as responses to questionnaires that we shared with the OIG, Office of Investigations, Kansas City Regional Office and the Utah OIG, Medicaid Services Program Integrity.

We have concluded that the Utah MFCU meets the Federal requirements for operation of a Medicaid Fraud Control Unit and recertify the MFCU for the one-year period of January 1, 2026, and ending December 31, 2026. A reapplication for recertification should be submitted to OIG no later than November 1, 2026.
