The Office of Inspector General (OIG) has reviewed the recertification package submitted by the U.S. Virgin Islands Medicaid Fraud Control Unit (MFCU or Unit), including the Unit's performance narrative and the responses to the director's questionnaire. We also reviewed the Unit's Annual Statistical Report data as well as the responses to the questionnaires that we submitted to OIG's Office of Investigations, New York City Regional Office; and to the U.S. Virgin Islands Program Integrity, Department of Human Services.
