As part of the recertification process, we have reviewed the following documentation submitted by the South Carolina Medicaid Fraud Control Unit (MFCU): the MFCU's recertification package, including the MFCU's performance narrative and the responses to the director's recertification questionnaire. We have also reviewed the MFCU's Annual Statistical Report. Additionally, we reviewed the responses to the questionnaires received from the Office of Inspector General's, Office of Investigations, Atlanta Regional Office; and from the South Carolina Department of Health and Human Services.

We have concluded that the South Carolina MFCU meets the Federal requirements for operation of a Medicaid Fraud Control Unit and recertify the MFCU for a one-year period beginning January 1, 2026, and ending December 31, 2026. A reapplication for recertification should be submitted to OIG no later than November 1, 2026.
